

**NORTH ATTLEBOROUGH PLANNING BOARD
EMERGENCY MEETING
THURSDAY, MAY 28, 2009**

The North Attleboro Planning Board held an emergency meeting on Thursday, May 28, 2009 at 6:05 P.M. at the Town Hall, 43 South Washington Street, North Attleborough, Massachusetts. Board members Richard Peterson, Richard Thimot, Donald Cerrone, Richard Houle-chairman and Mary E. Burgess-Town Planner, were present.

The Board discussed the additional budget cuts required by the Board of Selectmen in order to balance the Budget.

The Board was asked to cut an additional 1.58% from the proposed FY10 Budget.

The Planning Board decided on the following additional cuts:

- Deduct \$250 from Mileage which leaves a \$0 balance
- Deduct \$250 from Training which leaves a \$0 balance
- Deduct \$500 from Engineering which leaves a \$1500 balance
- Deduct \$430 from Memberships and Dues which leaves a \$0 Balance.

As part of the Town Planner's union contract, the Town/Board is to pay for all of the professional memberships therefore the Planner will review this deduction with Human Resources as to whether it can be deducted. However, the Planner has offered to give it up regardless.

A motion was made by Richard Thimot and seconded by Richard Peterson to approve the budget as amended. An unanimous vote followed, 4-0.

The Planning Board continued their meeting to the Selectmen's meeting to hold interviews for the appointment of the new member.

The Planning Board returned to the Planning Board office at 6:45 pm and introduced the new member, Scott Weymouth.

A motion was made by Richard Thimot and seconded by Richard Peterson to adjourn the meeting at 6:50pm. An unanimous vote followed, 4-0.
