SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING - THE FOLLOWING ITEMS CAN BE COMBINED IN ONE LARGE WHEELED RECYCLING CART: GLASS, PLASTIC, ALUMINUM, METAL CANS, PAPER AND CARDBOARD

Glass	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Clear, green, brown, bottles and jars only 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Rinse clean ◆ Labels, caps, lids, and neck rings are OK ◆ Place in recycling bin 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ No broken glass ◆ No other glass (light bulbs, window glass, mirrors, dishes, etc.)
Plastic Containers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Rigid containers such as milk and water jugs, soda and detergent bottles marked with recycling symbols containing the following numbers: 1,2,3,4,5,6, or 7 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Rinse clean ◆ Labels, caps, lids, and neck rings are OK ◆ Place in recycling bin 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ No unmarked items ◆ No plastic wrap or film ◆ No plastic plant pots ◆ No plastic bags ◆ No styrofoam
Aluminum	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Deposit and non-deposit aluminum cans ◆ Foil pie plates ◆ Aluminum trays 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Rinse clean ◆ Cans can be flattened or nested to save space ◆ Place in recycling bin 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ No foil ◆ No other aluminum items
Metal Cans	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Metal ("tin") cans only 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Rinse clean ◆ Cans can be flattened or nested to save space ◆ Place in recycling bin 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ No aerosol, paint, or motor oil cans ◆ No other metal items
Paper	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Newspapers ◆ Magazines ◆ Junk mail ◆ Catalogs ◆ Phone books ◆ Office paper 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Place in recycling bin, brown paper grocery bags, or tie with string ◆ Do not put in plastic bags 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ No soiled newspapers, tissues, or napkins ◆ No wax paper ◆ No styrofoam packing or peanuts
Cardboard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Corrugated cardboard ◆ Paperboard (cereal boxes, etc. with liners removed) ◆ Egg cartons (no styrofoam) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Cut or flatten cardboard ◆ Place in recycling bin ◆ No Plastic Bags 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ No food contaminated items ◆ No wax or foil coated items

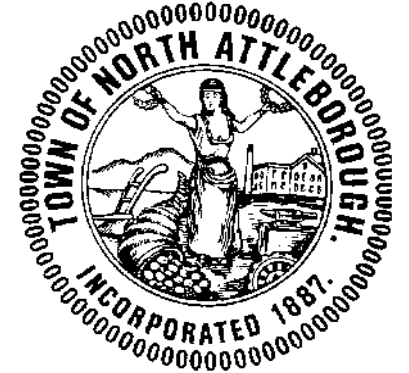

Payment of the annual solid waste fee each year (July 1 to June 30) entitles residents to the following services:

1. Weekly Curbside Pickup Of Trash

- Place curbside by **7:00 a.m.** on designated collection day
- Regular household trash must be in Town bags or regular bags with a Town Bag Tag on each bag
 - Town 20 lb. bags are 10 for \$15.00
 - Town 15 lb. bags are 10 for \$10.00
 - Town Bag Tags, good on each non-Town bag weighing up to 30 lbs., are \$3.00 each
 - See other side of this pamphlet for a list of where Town bags and tags can be purchased
 - Bulky Item Tags, one tag for each item weighing up to 30 lbs., are \$2.50 each
- Allowable bulky items are:
 - Regular couches (no hide away beds or recliners)
 - Stuffed chairs (no recliners)
 - Mattresses
 - Wood frame box springs
 - Small furniture and toys (wood, plastic, and glass)
 - Mirrors
 - Wood (up to 3' x 3' bundle tied)
 - Carpets (up to 3' long rolled & tied)
- **A couch weighing 55 lbs. would require 2 tags**

- ***When an observed Town holiday occurs within any week, that day's collection and any remaining collections for the week will be delayed by 1 day.***

2. Weekly Curbside Pickup Of Recyclables

- Recycling bins must be placed at curbside by **7:00 a.m.** on same day as trash pick-up
- Follow the recycling rules on the other side of this pamphlet

3. Recycling Center Sticker

- **Each household is entitled to 1 FREE recycling center sticker when annual fee is paid in full - a six (6) month sticker good until January 2009 when \$125 is paid**
- **A sticker may be requested by mail with a stamped self-addressed envelope and a copy of your auto registration**
- A 2nd sticker may be purchased for a fee of \$5.00 at the Solid Waste Department
 - Acceptable materials at the recycling center are:
 - Regular household trash in Town bags or bags with tags
 - Recyclables (same as curbside)
 - Freon-bearing appliances, i.e., air conditioners and refrigerators: **\$10.00 ea.**
 - Other appliances and gas cylinders: **\$10.00 ea.**
 - TVs & computer monitors: **\$15.00 ea.**

- Car tires with/without rim:
 - under 20" **\$2.00 ea.**
 - 20" and over **\$20.00 ea.**
- Waste (bagged), wood, scrap metal & microwave ovens: **\$.10 per lb.**

4. Curbside Pickups For Metal And White Goods Are Held The Last Full Week In March, June, And September

- **Participants must call 699-0151 by 12:00 noon on Thursday the week before the scheduled pickup**
- Items must be placed curbside by **7:00 a.m.** on Monday of the scheduled pickup week and left until picked up
 - Acceptable items:
 - Stoves, dishwashers, washers, dryers, and hot water tanks
 - Metals: < 6 feet & < 100 lbs.
 - NO air conditioners
 - NO refrigerators
 - NO gas cylinders

5. Household Hazardous Waste Days Are Held Each Spring and Fall at the Highway Dept., 240 Smith Street. Please contact the Solid Waste Department for scheduled dates and time.

- **To participate you must have a current Recycling Center sticker appropriately attached to your vehicle**

Limited to:

- 10 gallons liquid waste, 5 passenger tires with/without rims or 5 auto batteries

- Acceptable items:
 - Poisons and pesticides
 - Herbicides and fertilizers
 - Kerosene and other waste fuels
 - Oil based paints
 - Oven, toilet bowl and drain cleaners
 - Paint strippers, turpentine, and solvents
 - Swimming pool chemicals
 - Photographic chemicals
 - Antifreeze and motor oil
 - Auto batteries
- Unacceptable items:
 - Explosives, fireworks and ammunition.
 - Radioactive waste
 - Smoke detectors
 - Biomedical waste
 - Gas cylinders
 - Commercial and industrial waste

6. Yard Waste Disposal Program

- Yard located on Plain Street & operated by the DPW.

Billing Procedures

Trash removal program runs from 7/1 to 6/30 of each year. Bills are payable within 30 days of date of mailing. Late fees will be applied to accounts not paid within 30 days. Failure to pay a balance from a prior billing period shall result in a lien being placed on your property.
