

 - Current number of total positives in North Attleborough: **7212**
 - Actively Infectious: **38**
 - Cases last week: **27**
 - Current positivity rate: **12%**
 - Number of cases for the month of May: **436**

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT - Updates

- Situational Awareness: Mild Drought Conditions Declared for Southeastern MA
 - DPW has already issued a water ban for residential watering
 - Community:
 - Minimize overall water use
 - Limit outdoor watering to 1-day a week before 9:00AM and after 5:00PM
 - Odd numbered addresses on Tuesdays
 - Even numbered addresses on Thursdays
