

Below are key activities, that I think would be of interest:

PUBLIC HEALTH – Updates

- Nothing significant to report at this time.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT - Updates

- **Snow Operations Tabletop Exercise** – Conducted our annual tabletop exercise with Department Heads on October 21, 2022. Focused on the Town’s response during a major winter storm event. As a result of the exercise, we were able to identify some gaps in our response. We are working to correct those now. The North Attleborough team is now ready for winter.
- **CODE RED-** All residents, Boards, Committees, and Commission Members should all sign up for CODE RED notifications. This can be done by going to our website nattleboro.com and it is on the main page “**Emergency Alert Signup.**”

- **November 19, 2022- “Giving from the Heart”** fundraiser sponsored by DANA for JoAnn Cathcart. **See Attached**


OPERATIONS – Updates

- **Mansfield Bioscience Incubator Open House** – Attended on October 19, 2022
- **October 27, 2022- Tri-County High School** is sponsoring a breakfast and reporting on the MSBA feasibility study finding regarding Tri-County building options.
- **October 27, 2022** – Senator Feeney is sponsoring an **Economic Development Round Table** for Bristol & Norfolk County. This event is scheduled from 11 am to 12 pm in Attleboro.
- **October 30, 2022** -Assessors Valuations are Finalized
- **November 1, 2022-** Tax Day- Property and Real Estate Taxes are due
- **November 1, 2022** - Beach Gates at both Whiting’s and Falls Pond will be closing for the season.

- **November 3, 2022** – The Planning Board will hold a public hearing for the Kelley Blvd Smart Growth Overlay District – 40 R.
- **November 8, 2022** – Election Day!

- **November 9, 2022** – **Affordable Housing Forum** - Congressman Auchincloss is sponsoring an affordable housing stakeholders’ event with special guest HUD Regional Administrator Juana B. Matias. Discussion includes current programs and initiatives to foster the creation and preservation of affordable housing in the MA-04 district.
- **November 10, 2022** – **Climate Summit** - Congressman Auchincloss is sponsoring a climate summit to hear directly from leaders in academia, industry, and public policy about their efforts to curb climate change, and how Massachusetts will lead the nation in these efforts.
- **November 11, 2022**- Veterans Day Celebration with Wrentham & Plainville at 11:00AM. Details to be published shortly for this event.
- **November 27, 2022**- **Holiday Season Kick Off** begins.
 - Three events:
 1. Leftover Turkey Trott- 5K Run- in the morning at **11:00AM**, before the parade. This event will also serve as a potential fund/awareness event for children in need this holiday season. There are already **129 Participants signed up as of today!**
 2. Santa Parade at **3:00PM**
 3. Kris Kringle Mart- Christmas Market consisting of local vendors in front of Town Hall immediately following the parade.
