SUBJECT: Town Manager Report

Below are key activities, that I think would be of interest:

1. Emergency Management Updates:

a. Extreme Heat Warning

- i. An extreme heat warning is in effect until Tuesday, June 24, at 8 p.m., with temperatures expected to reach up to 110°F. Residents are urged to take precautions to prevent heat-related illnesses.
- ii. Cooling centers will be open to the public: Richards Memorial Library, located at 118 N Washington St., will operate Monday through Thursday from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., and Friday and Saturday from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. The Senior Center at 204 Elm St. will be open Monday through Thursday from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and Friday from 8 a.m. to noon.
- iii. To help residents stay cool, the World War II Memorial Pool will have extended hours until 8:30 p.m. today, tomorrow (June 24), and Thursday (June 25). Admission is free for residents who present a photo ID along with a current utility or tax bill.

As of Monday, June 2, residents can request residential spray for adulticide from the Bristol County Mosquito Control Project.

Residents are asked to include their last name and full address, including zip code, in their request. Please note that a request is for one application and not for the whole season. If you need to have an additional application, please send another request with the same information. Spraying will begin on June 9 between the hours of 2 a.m. and sunrise.

- iii. Rain Barrels and Compost Bins Available for Purchase at Recycling Center

The Solid Waste Department has rain barrels and accessories for residents to purchase. The Solid Waste Department has 2 green barrels (\$61.00/each), 2 gray barrels (\$61.00/each), 2 unpainted black barrels (\$56.00/each), 6 terra cotta barrels (\$52.00/each), 3 brown barrels (\$61.00/each), 5 small diverters (\$30.00/each) and 2 10lb. bags of polished stones (\$24.00/bag) available for residents to purchase. Quantities are limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Additionally, approximately 50 kitchen scrap buckets and liners are available for **FREE** at the Solid Waste Department to assist community members with their composting efforts. Residents can grab their free kitchen scrap buckets and liners, which allow them to temporarily store their food scraps until they'd like to empty them in either their compost bins or at the Recycling Center.
