

Measure 2026-010- To request that the Town Council accept the funds being paid to the Town per MGL Chapter 44 Section 53A as part of a transportation improvement agreement with the developer to the Department of Public Works for the purpose of Traffic Improvements on Kelley Boulevard.

Purpose and Justification:

To request that the Town Council appropriate funds received by the Town through a Development Agreement with a developer to the Department of Public Works, to be used specifically for traffic improvements on Kelley Boulevard

As part of the Kelley Boulevard 40R Development, the developer agreed to contribute \$500,000 toward a traffic improvement project to be constructed by the Department of Public Works along Kelley Boulevard in both North Attleborough and Plainville. To date, the Town has received the full \$500,000 payment. These funds will help offset the anticipated \$6–7 million total project cost.

Appropriating these funds directly to DPW ensures they are immediately available for their intended purpose and prevents them from being deposited into the General Fund, where they would otherwise fall to free cash in the next fiscal year. This action provides both fiscal responsibility and operational readiness in advancing the Kelley Boulevard traffic improvements.

The Town Council met on August 25, 2025, and on behalf of the Town Council, a motion was made by Vice-President Lapointe to refer **Measure 2026-010-** To request that the Town Council accept the funds being paid to the Town per MGL Chapter 44 Section 53A as part of a transportation improvement agreement with the developer to the Department of Public Works for

the purpose of Traffic Improvements on Kelley Boulevard to the Finance Sub-Committee for further review and consideration.

Councilor Donovan seconded the motion.

Motion carried. 8-0.

The Finance Sub-Committee met on August 25, 2025, and on behalf of the Committee, a motion was made by John Donohue to **Measure 2026-010-** To request that the Town Council accept the funds being paid to the Town per MGL Chapter 44 Section 53A as part of a transportation improvement agreement with the developer to the Department of Public Works for the purpose of Traffic Improvements on Kelley Boulevard back to the Full Town Council with a favorable recommendation.

Councilor Wagner seconded the motion.

Motion carried. 6-0.

The Town Council met on September 8, 2025, and on behalf of the Town Council, a motion was made by Councilor Simmons to approve **Measure 2026-010-** To request that the Town Council accept the funds being paid to the Town per MGL Chapter 44 Section 53A as part of a transportation improvement agreement with the developer to the Department of Public Works for the purpose of Traffic Improvements on Kelley Boulevard.

Vice-President Lapointe seconded the motion.

Motion carried. 8-0.
