

Measure 2026-015- Request Authorization to Re-purpose Dormant Capital Project Funds to Town Hall Facilities Improvement Fund.

Purpose and Justification:

The purpose of this measure is to reallocate unused resources from prior capital appropriations to meet current needs for maintaining and improving Town Hall facilities. By consolidating these idle funds into a newly established Town Hall Improvement Fund, the Town can ensure that necessary improvements are properly supported without requiring new appropriations.

The two capital project funds identified for re-purposing are A16/13 STM, Establish and Maintain the North Attleboro Community Partnership Fund, and A30/16 OTM, Appropriate Funds for Consultants for Community Rating System. These funds carry balances of \$37,427.60 and \$13,600 respectively and have remained unused since approval. Leaving funds unused does not benefit the Town. Re-purposing these funds to a Town Hall Improvement Fund is a fiscally responsible action that maximizes the use of existing resources, reduces the need for new appropriations, and directly supports the upkeep of critical municipal facilities.

The Town Council met on August 25, 2025, and on behalf of the Town Council, a motion was made by Vice-President Lapointe to refer **Measure 2026-015-** Request Authorization to Re-purpose Dormant Capital Project Funds to Town Hall Facilities Improvement Fund to the Finance Sub-Committee for further review and consideration.

Councilor Donovan seconded the motion.

Motion carried. 8-0.

The Finance Sub-Committee met on September 3, 2025, and on behalf of the Committee, a motion was made by John Donohue to **Measure 2026-015-** Request Authorization to Re-purpose Dormant Capital Project Funds to Town Hall Facilities Improvement Fund back to the Full Town Council with a favorable recommendation.

Councilor Costello seconded the motion.

Motion carried. 6-0.

The Town Council met on September 8, 2025, and on behalf of the Town Council, a motion was made by Councilor Simmons to approve **Measure 2026-015-** Request Authorization to Re-purpose Dormant Capital Project Funds to Town Facilities Improvement Fund as Amended.

Vice-President Lapointe seconded the motion.

Motion carried. 9-0.
