

About the Elder Dental Program

The Elder Dental Program is a free service that connects low income adults (ages 60+) with local dentists who volunteer to treat patients at greatly discounted fees.

Who is Eligible?

- Older adults, ages 60 and older
- Residents of cities and towns served by the Elder Dental Program
Bristol County & Southern Norfolk County
- Elders with no dental insurance
- Low-Income seniors




