

# **Commercial/Industrial Electrical Fee Schedule** **(To Include Multi-Family Dwellings - 3 Units or more)**

Each Dwelling Unit requires their own Permit for work within that unit. Ex. 1st floor and 2nd floor apt. being renovated requires a permit for the first floor and a separate permit for the 2nd floor. Any work in basement or common area also requires their own permit

**New Multi Family Dwelling (3 or More Units) - \$175.00/per unit**

**Renovations/Alterations to Existing Multi-Family (Common and Exterior Areas Only of Multi-Family Dwellings in Excess of 3 Units) \$4.00 per Device (\$50.00 Min. – Max. \$175.00)**

**New and/or Additions to Commercial/Industrial Structures**  
**\$4.00 per device, appliance outlet, etc (\$75.00 Min. – Max. \$5000.00)**

**Underground Service - \$50.00 (per trench)**

**Renovations And/Or Alterations to Existing Structures** (appliances, outlets, etc.)  
**\$4.00 per device (\$75.00 Min. – Max. \$5000.00)**

**Annual Maintenance - \$150.00**

**Carnival - \$200.00**

**Demolish - \$100.00**

**Solar Panel(s) - \$10.00 per panel (Max \$1000.00)**

**Misc – All Main Devices Listed Below (\$40.00 each)**

**\*RE-INSPECTION FEE (failed and/or additional inspections) - \$35.00**

**Off Hours Inspection Special Request (pending availability) – Flat fee of \$150.00 in addition to standard permit fee - \*\* Fee's may be subject to change based on scope of work & must be paid in full prior to inspector being on site\*\***

**Work done without any permits on record will be subject to the cost of the permit plus a \$500.00 Fee, or double the permit fee, whichever is higher. Work done with a permit, but exceeding the scope of the original permit, will need a supplemental permit for the additional work and will be subject to a double fee.**
