

## **GAS PERMIT FEE SCHEDULE** **RESIDENTIAL**

**(To Include: Single-Family, Duplex, Townhouse, Modular Homes, and Mobile Homes)**

Each Dwelling Unit requires their own Permit for work within that unit. Ex. 1st floor and 2nd floor apt. being renovated requires a permit for the first floor and a separate permit for the 2nd floor. Any work in basement or common area also requires their own permit

### **New Residential and/Or Alterations**

**\$50.00 plus \$10.00 per fixture**

**Mobile Home (new only) - \$100.00**

**Hot Water Heater (New or replacement) – \$50.00 each permit**

## **COMMERCIAL**

**(To Include Common Areas and Exterior of Multi-Family Dwellings with 3 or more Units)**

Each Dwelling Unit requires their own Permit for work within that unit. Ex. 1st floor and 2nd floor apt. being renovated requires a permit for the first floor and a separate permit for the 2nd floor. Any work in basement or common area also requires their own permit

### **New and/or Alterations to Existing Multi-Family (Common and Exterior Areas Only of Multi-Family Dwellings with 3 or more Units)**

**(\$100.00 plus \$20.00 per fixture)**

### **New and/or Alterations to Commercial/Industrial Structures**

**(\$100.00 plus \$20.00 per fixture)**

**Hot Water Heater (new or replacement) - \$50.00 for each permit.**

**RE-INSPECTION FEE (failed and/or additional inspections) - \$35.00**

**Off Hours Inspection Special Request (pending availability) – Flat fee of \$150.00 in addition to standard permit fee - \*\* Fee's may be subject to change based on scope of work & must be paid in full prior to inspector being on site\*\***

**Work done without any permits on record will be subject to the cost of the permit plus a \$500.00 Fee, or double the permit fee, whichever is higher. Work done with a permit, but exceeding the scope of the original permit, will need a supplemental permit for the additional work and will be subject to a double fee.**
