

PLUMBING PERMIT FEE SCHEDULE

RESIDENTIAL

(To Include: Single-Family, Duplex, Townhouse, Modular Homes, and Mobile Homes)

Each Dwelling Unit requires their own Permit for work within that unit. Ex. 1st floor and 2nd floor apt. being renovated requires a permit for the first floor and a separate permit for the 2nd floor. Any work in basement or common area also requires their own permit

New and/or Alterations to Existing Residential Structures

\$50.00 plus \$10.00 per fixture

Underground Service (additional Fee) - \$40.00

Mobile Home (new ONLY) - \$100.00

Hot Water Heater (new or replacement) - \$50.00

COMMERCIAL

(To Include: Multi-Family Dwellings with 3 or More Units)

Each Dwelling Unit requires their own Permit for work within that unit. Ex. 1st floor and 2nd floor apt. being renovated requires a permit for the first floor and a separate permit for the 2nd floor. Any work in basement or common area also requires their own permit

New and/or Alterations to Existing Multi-Family (Common and Exterior Areas Only of Multi-Family Dwellings with 3 or More Units)

(\$100.00 plus \$20.00 per fixture)

New and/or Alterations to Commercial/Industrial Structures

(\$100.00 plus \$20.00 per fixture)

Underground Service - \$50.00 (per Trench)

Oil Water Separator (gasoline trap) \$150.00

Hot Water Heater (new or replacement) - \$50.00

Demolish - \$100.00

RE-INSPECTION FEE (failed and/or additional inspections) - \$35.00

Off Hours Inspection Special Request (pending availability) – Flat fee of \$150.00 in addition to standard permit fee - ** Fee's may be subject to change based on scope of work & must be paid in full prior to inspector being on site**

Work done without any permits on record will be subject to the cost of the permit plus a \$500.00 Fee, or double the permit fee, whichever is higher. Work done with a permit, but exceeding the scope of the original permit, will need a supplemental permit for the additional work and will be subject to a double fee.
