

Measure 2024-123-Funding for Snow and Ice Deficit FY2024

Purpose and Justification:

The Snow and Ice Budget is currently in deficit due to expenses incurred for snow removal, salting and sanding and the purchase of materials during the winter snow season. The DPW Director provided spreadsheets itemizing the expenses by snow and ice event, which are attached to this measure. The spreadsheets indicate the current deficit within the budget and the total amount needed to fund the account.

The Town Council met on June 10, 2024, and on behalf of the Town Council, a motion was made by Vice-President Simmons to refer Measure 2024-123-Funding for Snow and Ice Deficit FY2024 in the amount of \$29,977.50 to the Finance Sub-Committee for further review and consideration.

The motion was seconded by Councilor Slobogan.

Motion carried. 9-0 UNANIMOUS

The Finance Sub-Committee met on June 12, 2024, and on behalf of the Town Council, a motion was made by Councilor Donovan to refer Measure 2024-123- Measure 2024-123-Funding for Snow and Ice Deficit FY2024 in the amount of \$29,977.50 back to the Full Town Council with a favorable recommendation.

The motion was seconded by Councilor Costello.

Motion carried. 5-0 UNANIMOUS

The Town Council met on June 24, 2024, and on behalf of the Town Council, a motion was made by Vice-President Simmons to approve Measure 2024-123- Measure 2024-123-Funding for Snow and Ice Deficit FY2024 in the amount of \$29,977.50.

The motion was seconded by Councilor Slobogan.

Motion carried. 8-0 UNANIMOUS
