**Measure 2025-017-Appropriate \$8,400 from proceeds of the Department of Public Utilities (DPU) Transportation Network Company (TNC) Division to be used for the purchase of a 3-year renewal of software licenses for speed radar control signage for the Police and Public Works Departments.**

**Purpose and Justification:**

The TNC Division of the DPU collects \$0.20 per ride assessment for all ride-shares that originate in North Attleborough. These funds are distributed annually and are required to be used for improvements to the transportation network. The Police and DPW have utilized permanent and mobile speed radar signs throughout Town to monitor and control speeds. This system allows the departments to download information without having to visit the controllers. There are currently as pairs of speed radars in Town.

The Town Council met on October 28, 2024, and on behalf of the Town Council, a motion was made by Vice-President Simmons to approve Measure 2025-017-Appropriate \$8,400 from proceeds of the Department of Public Utilities (DPU) Transportation Network Company (TNC) Division to be used for the purchase of a 3-year renewal of software licenses for speed radar control signage for the Police and Public Works Departments.

The motion was seconded by Councilor Costello.
