Who can receive assistance? Any working person!

The Working Person's Food Pantry will assist working people with emergency food assistance during trying times.

Many working people are unable to make it to traditional food pantries, which are usually opened during the day when people are working. Sometimes working people find themselves in a tight situation. Trying to decide if a bill needs to be paid or to purchase food for the table can sometimes pose a tough decision.

What to bring: A picture ID and a recent pay stub.

The working person's food pantry will also have information available about other programs. Working people may not think they are eligible for programs such as Fuel Assistance, Food Stamps, WIC, Medical Assistance, Holiday Assistance Programs, clothing and much more.

How to donate: Perhaps you are doing better than most working families. Non-perishable food is always accepted each Thursday night. It is so easy to drop donations on your way home from work each Thursday. **Your donations can help others.**
